He enjoyed spending time with his wife of 34 years and their two daughters. Paul's friends and family describe him as a gentle giant who had a great smile that accompanied his sarcastic sense of humor.

Paul's active lifestyle began when he was young, playing baseball in the alleys of Baltimore City. Through an academic scholarship, Paul attended the Gilman School in Baltimore. During his time at Gilman, he played football, basketball, and baseball. Through school, he was able to cultivate lifelong friendships and learn foundational values that would carry him through life.
